

## RENCONTRES SANS FRONTIÈRES 2020

### Beach volleyball rules

#### Players / teams

1. Registered players may only play for their team.
2. Teams are made up of five players, with at least two players of different nationalities and at least two female players. Each team will be allowed to field no more than three players of the same nationality. If the minimum of two female players per team is not respected, the opposing team will receive five points. One female player on each team must be on the court at all times.
3. Team captains must arrive at 9:00 and before 10:00 and bring:
  - a list stating the surname and first name of all players in their team.
  - This list must be handed in before the tournament begins.
4. All players must wear a T-shirt.

#### Matches

5. Referees will be provided by the organisers.
6. Matches that are suspended due to injury for more than five minutes will be called off and the score at that point recorded.
7. Any player that excessively questions a referee's decisions may lead to their team having to forfeit the match.
8. Teams that are more than five minutes late for a match will forfeit the match by two sets to zero.
9. Teams will change sides after 10 minutes. Referees shall penalise teams for wasting time.
10. The referee must sign the scorecard after the match.
11. Teams are awarded two points for a win, one for a draw, and none for a loss.
12. The criteria for choosing the finalists are the number of points, the points difference and the positive balance of the points scored.
13. Only the referees and the organisers are entitled to resolve any disputes that may arise during a match.

#### General rules

14. Teams that fail to show up will be disqualified.
15. The organisers reserve the right to change the game format and the schedule at any time.
16. Situations not covered by these rules will be resolved by the organiser.
17. Indoor and outdoor sports facilities provided by the City of Luxembourg must be treated with care and respect. Anyone failing to do so will be escorted off the site by security staff and denied future access.
18. Registered teams accept and undertake to abide by these rules.
19. The organisers shall not be held liable in the event of an accident or if anything is stolen.
